***Recirculated* Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the**
Sacramento Recycling and Transfer Station – North Project (Job Number 9440)

The City of Sacramento completed the *Recirculated* Draft EIR for the Sacramento Recycling and Transfer Station - North project. The document is now available for public review and comment. A copy of the document is available for review at the Central Library (828 I Street), City Hall (New City Hall, 915 I Street, 3rd Floor receptionist window), and at the North Permit Center (2101 Arena Blvd., Suite 200 - public counter hours: 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., M - F). Copies of the Recirculated DEIR are available at the North Permit Center. The Recirculated Draft EIR and Draft EIR are also available for review on the City's website at: <http://www.cityofsacramento.org/nats>.

Subsequent to the release of the Draft EIR, the project applicant notified the City that there could be temporary outdoor storage of recycled materials waiting transport by commercial recyclers. The outdoor storage would generally occur when storage space within the main building reaches capacity as a result of greater-than-average volumes. These materials could include paper, cardboard, plastics, metals, glass, wood, scrap metal, electronic waste, batteries, mercury-containing electronic waste, and white goods (refrigerators and other large appliances). These materials, with the exception of the white goods, would be contained in bales, containers, or on shrink-wrapped pallets, or some other containment system. No green waste or municipal solid waste would be stored outside.

In accordance with Section 15088.5 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Title 14, CCR, Chp. 3), a lead agency is required to recirculate an EIR when changes to the project are made after public notice is given of the availability of the draft EIR, but prior to certification.

In accordance with CEQA, only the chapters of the DEIR that were modified to include the discussion and analysis of the temporary outdoor storage are being circulated for public review and comment. The issues discussed within the Recirculated EIR, as they relate to outdoor storage, are: Land Use and Aesthetics; Air Quality and Odors; Noise; Hazards and Public Health; and Hydrology, Drainage, and Water Quality.

In accordance with Section 15088.5(f)(2) of the CEQA Guidelines, commentors are asked to limit their comments to the revised sections of the Draft EIR. The revised portions of the Draft EIR show in this Recirculated DEIR as **bold, underlined text** (for additional text) and ~~striketrough-text~~ (for removed text). Written comments should be received **NO LATER THAN 5:00 p.m., Monday, October 29, 2007** at:
